



FJPE Leadership Course

The Art of Being a Community Leader

The Jewish Progressive Federation in Spain is offering a 35 hour leadership course with the generous support of the EUPJ and Arzenu Olami. It is aimed at building and nurturing a new leadership group within the Reform/Progressive communities in the Iberian Peninsula and strengthening our connection with Israel.

The course kicks off with the FJPE Shabbaton in Santiago de Compostela, Spain 24-26 May 2019. Ten online sessions will run from June to October, and the course will finish with a Shabbaton in Rota (Cádiz), Spain 1-3 Nov. 2019.

Participants will learn the ins and outs of community building and fundraising as well as an introduction to the role of Shaliach/Sh'lilat Tzibur to be presented by Mr. David Pollak and Rabbi Alona Lisitsa, among many other interesting topics to be given by Rabbi Steve Burnstein, Rabbi Haim Casas and various leaders of the Spanish Reform/Progressive communities.

A focus on Reform involvement in the Israeli institutions will be given by Arzenu Olami and an overview of Israeli politics given by a subject matter expert in the WZO's Department for Diaspora Activities. Sessions will include required readings, online discussions and a follow-up with practical exercises.
