Dear Mrs. von der Leyen,

Thank you very much for all you and the European Commission have done so far to support European Jewish communities in the aftermath of the October 7th terror attacks on Israel and innocent Israeli citizens, men, women and children, by Hamas.

Writing on behalf of more than 170 member congregations of the European Union for Progressive Judaism, across Europe. We ask you to please pass on to the members of the European Parliament our urgent request to the EU to act immediately and decisively to secure the safe release of all hostages held in Gaza irrespective of their nationalities. As surely all members of the EU Parliament will be aware, that the act of taking civilians as hostages is considered an exceptionally serious war crime and a violation of the principles and rules of basic international law applicable in armed conflict.

It must therefore be the clear priority of all actors exerting influence on the situation in the Middle East to ensure that all hostages are brought home safely without delay.

Until their release can be secured, we urge you to demand that the International Red Cross be granted access to all hostages to verify their well-being.

Judaism sanctifies life, please support our urgent request.
